



SHOC Football Club Selection Guideline 2012

The objective of this guideline is give players, coaches, parents and the wider SHOC community a better understanding of the selection process from week to week and over the course of the year. This has been developed in an attempt to provide further clarity and transparency to selections undertaken at the SHOC Football Club.

The Selection Panel

- A Grade - A Grade Coach, Assistant Coaches, B Grade Coach, Football Manager.
- B Grade - A Grade Coach, Assistant Coaches, B Grade Coach, Football Manager.
- C Grade - C Grade Coach, Assistant Coaches, Football Manager.
- D Grade -D Grade Coach, Assistant Coaches, Football Manager.
- E Grade - E Grade Coach, Assistant Coaches, Football Manager.

Trial Game Selection & Pre-Season

- A & B Grade selection for the three organised pre-season (SMOSH, Goody Saints and ROCS) games will be determined by a combination of:
 - Trainings attended (prior Christmas training has more significant weighting)
 - Fitness Level (we don't want to risk injury to un fit players)
 - Availability due to summer sports & Jobs (cricket, tennis, lifesaving, work etc, communication with the senior coach is a prerequisite for this consideration)
 - Commitment to SHOC 2012

Selection Based on Form

- All Best Player Awards will be determined using the 5,4,3,2,1 system and ideally having 3 different voters. (3 voters will be enforced in the A and B Grade and C-E grade will be at the discretion of the coach with approval of the football committee with the aim of being consistent)
- All votes will be submitted following the game to the senior coach for collation and be used in the determination of best and fairest awards at the end of the season and a determination of form.
- Form will be judged on 2-3 weeks worth of performance within this voting system (not solely).
- Players whose form is improving will be given the opportunity to train with a higher grade the following week if they wish to do so.



Selection after injury or absence

- A player, who is injured, rested or absent for only one week will be automatically available for selection at the discretion of the coach of that team for the following week; This time period may be extended to two weeks depending on the circumstances but will need to be approved by the Football Committee.
- Injuries that require more than two weeks without football will be required to undertake a fitness test (to be determined based on the type of injury)
- Form prior to injury/absence will be considered in the selection process

Notification of Selection

- The first round of football in 2012 all players will receive a phone call from the coach of the team that you have been selected in for that week.
- Following rounds phone calls will be made to players whose situation changes:
 - If the player is promoted the coach of the team you are promoted to will contact you;
 - If the player is demoted the coach of the team you have been demoted from and the coach of the team you will play in will contact you; and
 - In the event that a rotation of players is required to give someone a game you will be contacted by the coach of that team to let you know of this situation. This rotation will be noted by the coach for future reference.
